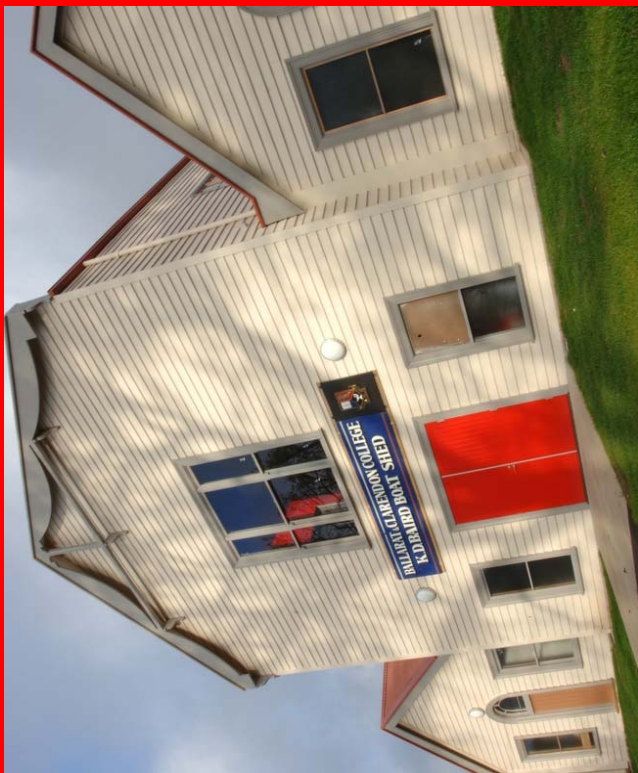

## Presentation of Oars Policy

In recognition of their achievement Ballarat Clarendon College first boys or girls crew members who win the Head of the Lake regatta will receive an oar painted in Ballarat Clarendon College colours. The coxswain will receive the boat's rudder.

The oars to be presented will be selected by the Director of Rowing in consultation with the Principal. Painting of the oars is the responsibility of the Director of Rowing or his/her delegate.

Should a student from a winning first crew wish to retain the oar he or she rowed with in the Head of the lake, that oar is to be purchased at the current market value of a replacement oar. The approximate replacement cost in 2002 was \$500 per oar. Ballarat Clarendon College will pay for the painting of the oars.

## About the 1920 Club

The 1920 Club has been supporting rowing at Ballarat Clarendon College for more than 25 years. It was named after the first year Ballarat College won the Head of the Lake.

## Fund-raising

- Trailer equipped with barbeques
- Awards and trophies for current/past rowers

- End-of-season dinner for coaches/partners

## Meetings

Meetings are held on the first Monday of the month at 8pm at the Ballarat Clarendon College Boatshed. In first term meetings are held each first and third Monday of the month.

Also each Friday in February there is BYO Sunset Drinks at the boatshed between 6pm and 8pm.

## Regattas

The Ballarat Clarendon College supporters are easy to find alongside the bright red tents. A club trailer is sometimes taken. It has tea and coffee making facilities, a barbecue and cooking utensils. There is a roster for towing the trailer to regattas and erecting the tents. If you would like to assist please contact a member of the committee.

## What to take to a regatta

If you wish to have a barbecue lunch BYO your own food and drink. You will also need to bring chairs/rugs and do not forget your sunscreen. Most venues have stalls where you can buy programs, food and drinks.
