SPECIFIC INFORMATION

Music

Candidates are invited to perform two contrasting pieces on their main instrument which includes voice. If they are at similar standard on more than one instrument, candidates are asked to present one work on each instrument. An accompanist can be provided or candidates may provide their own.

Candidates also will be assessed on basic aural ability.

Drama

Candidates are invited to present two contrasting monologues of no longer than five-minutes each in duration that best demonstrates acting ability.

Candidates also may be required to complete a short improvisation exercise.

Dance

Candidates are invited to present two solo routines of their own choice in contrasting styles. Candidates should provide their own music.

Dress should be standard 'dance-class' wear.

Visual Arts

The process for students to enter for a Visual Arts Scholarship involves tasks which assess competencies in both written and practical aspects of art studies. Candidates should bring a folio of their creative work to present and discuss at the interview.

Candidates will be required to engage in the following activities:

- Imaginative drawing (15 minutes)
- Written task analysing an artwork (15 minutes)
- Interview with a panel of three professionals in the visual arts field (15 minutes)
