2026 Uniform Requirements

21 November 2025

Dear Parents

All items of clothing brought to school must be clearly marked with your child's name (full name, not just initials). Name tapes or writing must be permanent and waterproof.

The expectations should align with the school rules and as detailed by Heads of School. See summary below. House Teachers will complete regular checks regarding uniform and jewellery.

In the following list, 'Clarendon' refers to an item specifically produced for the school and 'Regulation' refers to an item approved by the school.

Basic Everyday Wear

• Clarendon blazer – worn as street wear with summer and winter uniforms and is compulsory for all formal occasions • Clarendon red jumper – a special jumper is available for Year 12 • Clarendon striped dress, length no higher than just above the knee • Clarendon tartan kilt, length no higher than just above the knee • Clarendon white shirt • As an alternative to the dress and/or kilt, girls may wear Regulation grey girls' trousers or shorts (sizes 4L-26L) or Regulation gunmetal grey boys' trousers or shorts • Black leather school shoes – boots or sports shoes are not acceptable; shoes must be without fancy buckles, without fancy metallic eyelets and without patterns, stripes or brocading; and they should be of a leather type capable of being polished to a shine • Regulation black, opaque tights, worn with kilt • Regulation white socks – long or short, but not sport-style • Clarendon backpack or Clarendon trolley bag • Hair accessories must be red or black only.	• Clarendon blazer – worn as street wear with summer and winter uniforms and is compulsory for all formal occasions • Clarendon grey jumper – a special jumper is also available for Year 12 students • Clarendon open-neck shirt, crested with short sleeves, no tie required or Regulation white shirt, standard-style collar, long or short sleeves to be worn with tie • Clarendon tie for boys in Years 5 to 10 or Clarendon VCE tie for boys in Years 11 or 12 • Regulation gunmetal grey shorts – may be worn all year, except for Senior Presentation Night, or Regulation gunmetal grey trousers, required for Presentation Night • Plain grey socks – worn with long trousers • Regulation walk socks – worn with shorts • Black leather school shoes – boots or sports shoes are not acceptable; shoes must be without fancy buckles, without fancy metallic eyelets and without patterns, stripes or brocading; and they should be of a leather type capable of being polished to a shine • Clarendon backpack or Clarendon trolley bag • Hair accessories must be red or black only.

Optional Everyday Wear

- Clarendon scarf or plain black or plain red scarf
- Clarendon wide-brim hat or peak cap
- Clarendon beanie.

Basic Physical Education/Sport Wear

- Clarendon black shorts
- Clarendon black track pants
- Clarendon hoodie
- Clarendon polo shirt
- Clarendon rugby top
- Clarendon wide-brim hat or peak cap (Terms 1 and 4)
- Regulation black or white sport socks
- Clarendon bathers, black bathers or black shorts
- Runners with non-marking soles.

Optional Physical Education/Sport Wear

- Clarendon soft shell jacket
- Clarendon House polo shirt – may be worn for House events
- Clarendon long-sleeve training top
- Clarendon or plain black leggings
- Plain-black rash vest – may be worn for swimming
- Clarendon black or white sport socks.

Specific Uniform Requirements for each of the Senior Sports Teams will be provided by the relevant coach before each season commences.
