

excellence scholarships

Ballarat Clarendon College is currently seeking applications for Excellence Scholarships from suitably credentialed students. These scholarships are open to students entering Years 9 to 11 in 2021 and offer up to 50% remission of tuition fees.

Clarendon's focus is *'Throughout a student's time at Ballarat Clarendon College our focus is to maximise their competence, skills and capacity so that, at the end of their time at school, when they stand on the threshold of their future, they can choose their "heart's desire".'*

Academic Scholarships are awarded to the most talented students based on test results. In recent years the Academic Scholarship program has been complemented by scholarships for students who display specific talents in the areas of visual arts, music, dance and drama.

Excellence Scholarships are awarded to students who display talent in a variety of areas including, but not restricted to, leadership, commitment to community service, sport, performing arts, visual arts and a degree of academic ability but, more importantly, sustained commitment to their studies. These scholarships are offered to give students opportunity to develop their talents in a quality educational environment. Clarendon offers inspiring, exceptional teaching in all of its programs and Excellence Scholarships offer talented students opportunities that they may not otherwise access without such support.

The attached application form is to be completed by the applicant with advice from parents.

The application should include:

- The names and telephone numbers of two referees;
- **copy** of the applicant's Semester 2 2019 School Report;
- **copy** of the applicant's most recent NAPLAN results;
- **copies** of any other documents you believe will support the application (eg certificates, awards, newspaper clippings).

If there is insufficient space to fully outline the application, then additional pages may be added. Original certificates should not be sent – photocopies will be sufficient. Please present the application in an A4 display folder.
