introduction

Ballarat Clarendon College is implementing this policy is to ensure that students and staff health and wellbeing are maintained at the highest levels within the school and that known medical conditions are treated in accordance with recommended government guidelines and statutory requirements.

medical conditions

The purpose of this policy is to facilitate an overarching policy regarding the effective care, administration of first aid and health management of students with asthma, allergies, anaphylaxis, diabetes and other medical conditions. All staff and volunteers will be made aware of the procedures as directed by this policy as well as the separate detailed policies covering each the specified medical conditions.

This overarching Medical Conditions Policy therefore points to the separate and detailed policies currently applicable, as follows:

- Allergy Management Policy
- Anaphylaxis Management Policy
- Asthma Management Policy
- Diabetes Management Policy
- Incident, Injury, Illness and Trauma Policy.

Ballarat Clarendon College will ensure that the separate policies as noted above are regularly reviewed and updated in accordance with the applicable regulations and all statutory requirements.

The separate policies as noted above, will direct the specific procedures to be followed and will also recognise the applicable requirements for Sturt Street campus, Mair Street Campus, Grassy Campus, and the Early Learning Centre if so required.

The separate policies and procedures will also detail all matters regarding:

- provision of a medical management plan for the student;
- development of a risk management plan in consultation with the parents / guardians of the student;
- development of a communications plan to ensure relevant staff and volunteers are fully informed about the specific policies, and to ensure that the student's parents/guardians can communicate any changes to the medical management plan and the risk management plan for the student;
- any other matters as directed by the applicable regulations.
